- Back end: Python, Flask, Vercel

Key factor in choosing this tech stack was to gain exposure in as many programming languages, webframeworks, and services as possible. Including cross-resource sharing (CORS), which combined with the 3-tier architecture, has deepened my understanding of how web-applications work, and how each tier interacts with each other. Allowing me to build progressively complicated, reliable scalable software, and becoming a truly tech-agnostic developer.
